DOMENICO WINES WINS MEDAL IN PACIFIC RIM INTERNATIONAL WINE COMPETITION

*Award Brings Total Number Of Domenico Medals
To 99 In Less Than 24 Months*

San Carlos, Calif.—May 31, 2007—Domenico Wines, one of the fastest growing, family-owned artisan wineries in the U.S., won a silver medal in the 2007 Pacific Rim International Wine Competition last month. As one of the largest and most respected wine competitions in the West, the Pacific Rim International Wine Competition receives entries from throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico, Argentina, Chile, Australia, and New Zealand. The Pacific Rim International Wine Competition has grown from approximately 100 entries in 1985 to more than 2,200 entries in 2005. The 2007 judging marks 22 years of wine competitions at the grounds of the National Orange Show in Southern California.

The new Domenico medal brings the total number of awards to 99 since Domenico was founded less than 24 months ago. The Domenico Wines that was awarded a medal is:
