DOMENICO WINES WINS TWELVE MEDALS IN SAN FRANCISCO CHRONICLE WINE COMPETITION

*Total Number Of Domenico Awards Now
58 In Less Than 18 Months*

San Carlos, Calif.—February 21, 2007—Domenico Wines, one of the fastest growing, family-owned artisan wineries in the U.S., took home twelve new medals in the 2007 San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition last month. Fifty-five professional wine judges representing trade, education, media and restaurants throughout the United States evaluated 3,800 wines entered by 1,573 wineries from 20 states. The San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition is the largest competition of American wines in the world. The twelve new Domenico medals bring the total number of awards to 58 since Domenico was founded less than eighteen months ago. Domenico Wines that were awarded medals are:

- 2004 Amador Zinfandel – Bronze
- 2004 Napa Valley Merlot – Bronze
- 2004 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon - Bronze

“We are extremely proud of the superior results that Domenico Wines achieved in this competition,” said Domenico master winemaker, Dominick Chirichillo. “This is also our second double gold award, which is given when there is a unanimous gold vote by all the judges,” Chirichillo said.

A public tasting of the award-winning wines will be held at the Festival Pavilion, Fort Mason, San Francisco, Calif. on February 24, 2007.
