**DOMENICO WINES WINS THREE MEDALS IN
WEST COAST WINE COMPETITION**

*New Awards Bring Total Number Of Domenico Medals
To 98 In Less Than 23 Months*

The competition has grown to become one of the wine industry's most prestigious judgments. Judges are a noteworthy group selected from winemakers, wine educators, wine media, wine/vineyard researchers and wine marketers.
