DOMENICO WINES AWARDED FIVE MEDALS IN THE DALLAS MORNING NEWS WINE COMPETITION

*Number Of Domenico Awards Now
89 In Less Than 22 Months*

San Carlos, Calif.—April 18, 2007—Domenico Wines, one of the fastest growing, family-owned artisan wineries in the U.S., won five medals in the 2007 Dallas Morning News Wine Competition last month. The 2007 competition marked the 23rd anniversary of the competition, which received 3,308 entries from 24 states and 16 countries. The competition is open to all wine regions of the world. The five new Domenico medals bring the total number of awards to 89 since Domenico was founded less than 22 months ago.

- 2004 Sangiovese – Bronze
- Orange Muscat – Bronze

The 2007 Dallas Morning News Wine Competition included 56 judges and remains the largest wine competition outside of California.
