DOMENICO WINES WINS SIX MEDALS IN GRAND HARVEST AWARDS WINE COMPETITION

*Total Number Of Domenico Awards Now
69 In Less Than 20 Months*

San Carlos, Calif.—March 15, 2007—Domenico Wines, one of the fastest growing, family-owned artisan wineries in the U.S., was awarded six new medals in the 2007 Grand Harvest Awards Wine Competition last month. The Grand Harvest Awards is the only wine judging event in North America that is based on terroir – a group of vineyards (or even vines) from the same region, belonging to a specific appellation, and sharing the same type of soil, weather conditions, grapes and wine making savoir-faire, which contribute to give its specific personality to the wine.

The six new Domenico medals bring the total number of awards to 69 since Domenico was founded less than 20 months ago. Domenico Wines that were awarded medals are:

2004 Merlot – Gold
2005 Santa Cruz Mountains Pinot Noir - Gold
2004 Cabernet Sauvignon - Silver
2005 Santa Cruz Mountains Chardonnay - Silver
2004 Zinfandel – Silver
2004 Sangiovese - Bronze

“The Grand Harvest Awards is a unique wine competition that highlights American viticultural regions by identifying the most outstanding wines from each of these areas,” said Domenico master winemaker, Dominick Chirichillo. “We are extremely proud to have Domenico Wines be recognized for these complex characteristics which contribute to the overall excellence and distinctiveness of the wines,” Chirichillo said.

At the Grand Harvest Awards, judges taste wines with other wines of the same appellation. Thus, with the cross-regional competition removed, the inherent quality of wines can be seen without the influences that sometimes eclipse even a wine of very high quality.
