DOMENICO WINES WINS 100th MEDAL AWARD

Milestone Achieved Within First Two Years Of Initial Wine Releases

San Carlos, Calif.—July 26, 2007—Domenico Wines, one of the fastest growing, family-owned artisan wineries in the U.S., announced that it has earned its 100th wine award within the first two years of releasing its initial wine offerings. Since spring 2005, Domenico Wines has been awarded a total of 100 wine medals, including three Double Gold Awards, 19 Gold Awards, and 34 Silver Awards. Domenico Wines was founded in 2004 by Dominick and Gloria Chirichillo, and in 2005 Domenico released its first 10 wine offerings to the public. Today, Domenico Wines offers 22 different hand-crafted wines, including six Italian varietals.

The Domenico Wine medals were awarded from numerous international and national wine competition events, including the American Wine Society Competition, the National Women's Wine Competition, and the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition, at which Domenico was awarded 12 medals (including a Double Gold for the 2004 Aglianico) in the 2007 judging.

“From the beginning, our vision was to produce extraordinary wines that expressed our passion and commitment to excellence in every step of the winemaking process,” said Domenico’s master winemaker, Dominick Chirichillo. “We are extremely proud of the achievements and recognition we’ve received in the past two years and are focused on continuing to grow the business and produce wines that exceed our customers’ expectations,” Chirichillo said.

To date, Domenico has produced 6,500 cases of its first two wine releases. Domenico produces its wine using California grapes grown in Alexander Valley, Napa Valley, Russian River Valley, Santa Cruz Mountains, Sonoma Coast, Amador County and Lodi. Domenico Wines are available through U.S. distributors/restaurants, including the Ritz Carlton in Marina del Rey, Calif.; and Spirits Unlimited, a major East Coast wine and spirits retailer. The winery is currently building its boutique wine distributor channels. Domenico Wines are priced from \$20 to \$35 per bottle.
